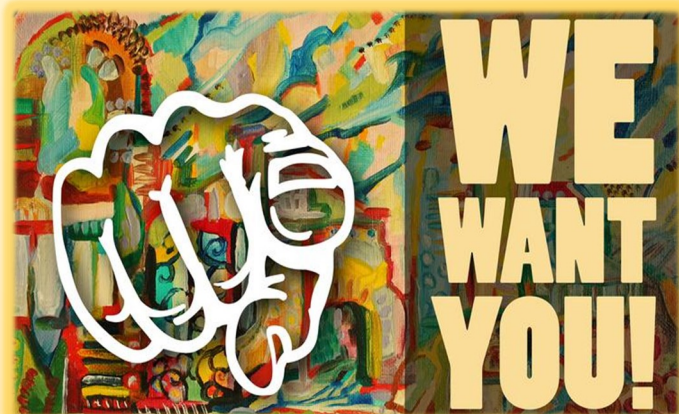
SUBMIT YOUR WORK FOR SELECTION IN OUR 34TH ANNUAL ART AUCTION

Happy New Year ! It is a little hard to believe that we have moved into another decade but if 2020 is anything like the year 2019, it is sure to be a productive year.

I want to thank all of you who donated to the Light Up A Life ceremony that was held on Friday, December 6, 2019. It was a very well attended heartfelt ceremony with music performed by the Yreka High School Choral group and the reading of names by our Hospice nurses. Your generosity (nearly \$20,000.00) in memory of your loved ones will directly support our patients and their families at the Madrone House...we are so very grateful.

As you know, Madrone Hospice isn't just about patient care. I'd like to share some year-to-date accomplishments with you: The Hospice Shop had 9,577 volunteer hours and total sales of \$192,483.60; The Heartisans Boutique had 4,656 volunteer hours and total sales of \$28,476.11. Our Madrone Senior Services provided 8,997 meals at the Senior Center and delivered 12,097 meals to homebound seniors; our patient care nurses and house staff provided quality, compassionate care to over 160 patients.

I am amazed and appreciative of all of our staff and volunteers as well as our wonderful community. Madrone Hospice, Inc. would not be as effective without the continuous support of our volunteers, staff and community.

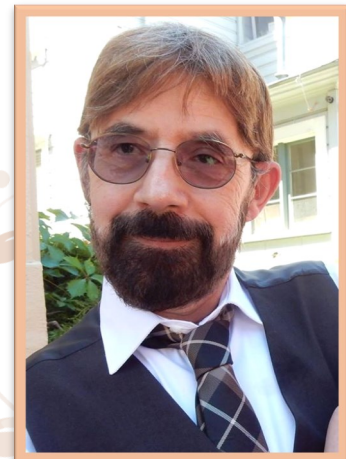

The Breakfast Club

The Breakfast Club is a group of locals that understand what it's like to go through a tremendous heartache from losing a loved one. Although they don't consider themselves a support group, nor focus on bereavement, its members all have one thing in common: Loss. Everyone has experienced some form of loss in their lifetime, and everyone is welcome. Together, the club provides a place of community

to help people get back to living life to the fullest. The members meet regularly for breakfast at Poor George's in Yreka, on the 2nd and 4th Friday of every month, at 10 am. The meetings are often just about camaraderie and encouragement. They also schedule various outings throughout the year, that the members choose. This past year the adventures included a trip to Iron Gate Fish Hatchery, a chair lift ride at the Mt. Shasta Ski Park, a Shasta Lake Dinner Cruise and an overnight venture to remote eastern Oregon's Fort Rock. The club also took a trip to a glass studio and the Medford Railroad Park.
